



First Aid

Duration: 1 Day

Course overview

This one day comprehensive course is conducted by a team of local and experienced paramedics. Designed to provide knowledge and skills in first aid response in a range of situations, this workshop includes CPR.

The course is assessed through a combination of written and practical assessment tasks. As part of the training simulated emergency scenarios of common accidents and injuries are used.

Topics included

- Allergic reactions/ Anaphylaxis
- Asthma/ Respiratory distress
- Basic wound care e.g. burns
- Bleeding
- Cardiac arrest
- Choking and airway obstruction
- Convulsions
- Fractures, sprains and strains
- Poisoning/ Envenomation
- Shock

Participants are required to complete one unit of competency to gain this qualification:

HLTAID003	Provide First Aid
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In accordance with Safe Work Australia's Code of Practice, "First Aid in the Workplace" first aid qualifications should be renewed every three (3) years.

This course is ideal for

- Any workers who may be required to provide a first aid response in a range of situations
- People who wish to become First Aid Officers
- Anyone wishing to keep their first aid certificate current
- Members of the public

CPR Refresher

CPR training is required to be refreshed every twelve (12) months in accordance with the Code of Practice. CPR refresher training is offered at the beginning of each First Aid course (first 3 hours), limited places available.

Learning outcomes

Participants will be able to:

- Respond to an emergency situation
- Apply appropriate first aid procedures
- Communicate details of the incident
- Evaluate the incident and own performance
