



Safe Work Near Power Lines

This course covers working safely up to the “safe approach distance” near power lines.

This course will educate workers how to work at safe distances specified in the Code of Practice for Work Near Power Lines.

For participants who have not completed this qualification, the two day initial course will need to be completed. Participants are eligible for refresher training if they have previously completed initial training.

A refresher is to be completed every 12 months.

It is ideal for workers such as:

- Crane drivers
- EWP operators
- Other mobile plant operators
- Tree workers
- Safety observers/spotters
- Supervisors responsible for safe system of work

Participants will complete theory and practical activities, working indoors and outdoors.

- Safe Approach Distances
- Electric Shock and Contact
- Emergency Procedure After Contact
