



Health & Safety Representative - Refresher Course

SafeWork NSW

Duration: 1 Day

Course overview

Health and Safety Representatives play an important role in the workplace, representing interests of workers in a work group. They also help to facilitate health and safety, through ongoing consultation between a PCBU (person conducting a business or undertaking) and the workers.

This refresher course provides a revitalisation of the understanding of the principles required to fulfil the powers/functions of a HSR.

If a HSR has completed the 5 day course (or the 1 Day Bridging Course) they are entitled to exercise their powers (to issue PINS or direct a person to cease unsafe work) for the term they hold office. This entitlement will still prevail for as long as an HSR is re-elected or until there is a change in the legislation.

Learning Outcomes

Participants will revisit information on the role and responsibility of a HSR and a HSR committee member. Any updated legislation and information will be covered and participants will be able to apply this learning to the workplace.

This course is ideal for

As stated by the WHS Regulation 2011 and for the purposes of section 72 (1) of the Act, a health and safety representative is entitled to attend the following courses of training in work health and safety:

- (a) an initial course of training of 5 days,
- (b) 1 day's refresher training each year, with the entitlement to the first refresher training commencing 1 year after the initial training.

Please note that the refresher training is not a requirement; it is an entitlement for HSRs if they wish to attend this or any other training as agreed between the HSR and the PCBU. Additionally, they are entitled to attend this each year of their elected term (3 years) or as requested by the HSR or Deputy HSR. See SafeWork NSW for more information.
