



Traffic Controller

Renewal or Refresher for current or recently expired cards

This course is for any person who is required to control traffic using a stop/slow bat. The course ensures that workers have a suitable level of professional knowledge and experience to ensure confidence in live traffic control situations.

Renewal – no training required

For participants who:

- Have current or recently expired (no more than 90 days) Traffic Controller card.
- Have worked in traffic control over the last 12 months

This is a simple administrative process of completing the application form and submitting it to LGTI. No need to attend training or complete a theory and practical assessment.

The RMS Renewal PhotoCard Application form requires the following:

- Record of 6 occurrences of work as a traffic controller in the last 12 months
- Signature and declaration by the PCBU/supervisor
- Current cards to be provided
- Current, digital photograph to be supplied
- Photo ID (eg driver's licence)

The renewal application must be completed prior to the card expiring if the holder needs to continue to work in traffic control.

Participants will be given a Statement of Completion (SoC) on receipt of application form, allowing them to work on a site for 90 days to allow for processing of plastic cards by RMS.

You can renew one card at a time – we recommend both at once, save time and money

If your Traffic Controller card has expired for more than 90 days you will need to do the initial training.

Refresher – training required

For participants who:

- Have current or recently expired Traffic Controller card
- Cannot record 6 occurrences of work as a traffic controller in the last 12 months

Participants attend a one day course, consisting of theory and practical activities. Refresher courses are held regularly at LGTI's Thornton Training Centre.

All advertised prices are inclusive of RMS Statement of Completion (SOC) and plastic PhotoCard fees.

Participants that are not successful in completing all assessments satisfactorily on the day would need to rebook and pay the course fee. The refresher course must be completed prior to the card expiring if the holder needs to continue to work in traffic control.

At the end of training, participants will be given a Statement of Completion (SoC) allowing them to work on a site for 90 days to allow for processing of plastic cards by RMS.

You can renew one card at a time – we recommend both at once, save time and money.

Pre-requisites for Refresher Training

Participants must:

- Have a current or recently expired (no more than 90 days) Traffic Controller card.
- Be physically able to perform traffic control duties:
 - Loading and unloading signage
 - Use a stop slow bat and two-way radio at the same time
- Be able to read and write, including:
 - Read signage
 - Read work instructions, SWMS etc
 - Complete a range of forms, checklists

Participants must be physically able to perform traffic control duties:

- Loading and unloading signage
- Using a stop slow bat and two-way radio at the same time

If your Traffic Controller card has expired for more than 90 days you will need to do the initial training.
