



# Hazardous Substances

Duration: 4 Hours Face to Face Training

## Course overview

This course provides real scenarios and activities for participants involved with storage and handling of workplace hazardous substances.

Employers are requested to provide chemical labels and SDS prior to training, so the course can be customized to the exact work practices of their staff.

If staff are required to handle and spray pesticides, they must do the ChemUse (AQF3) course – this course does not cover pesticide use.

Participants will complete theory and practical activities, working indoors and outdoors.

- Hazard identification and risk assessment
- Current SDS formats
- Reading labels and SDS
- Health risks
- Use of PPE
- Managing spills
- Correct storage
- Dangers of decanting
