Course overview

LGTI's Asbestos Awareness course will enable participants to understand how a work site with asbestos should be managed – by them or by others working on the same site. It will help them to identify safe working conditions where asbestos is present. This course also includes information of a general nature about the removal of asbestos.

Those who are not required to remove asbestos, but who may come into contact with, and/or be working on sites where others are removing asbestos.

- Landfill operators
- Plumbers, builders, renovators, demolition workers, etc.

Topics included

- Identification of types of asbestos
- Health effects
- Regulatory requirements
- Codes of practice and other guidelines
- Sampling and removal procedures
- PPE and suitable tools used when dealing with asbestos
- Decontamination of people
- Waste collection, transport and disposal of asbestos

Participants will be able to:

- Understand the different types of asbestos and how they are classified
- Understand the health effects of working around asbestos
- Recognize the legislative requirements and workplace processes when dealing with asbestos
- Outline the techniques for removal of bonded asbestos, including tools and PPE used
